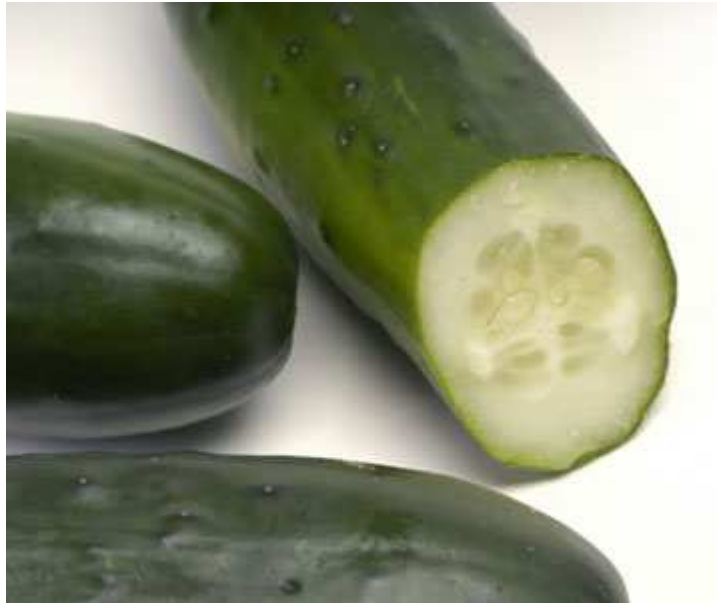

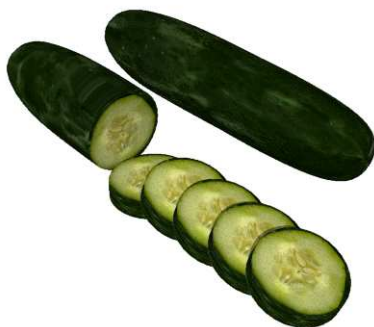

APOVF COCUMBERS

The cucumber (*Cucumis sativus* L.) belong to the family of Cucurbitaceae. It is an annual plant with creeping or climbing stem, producing fruits from 20 to 30 cm long. The plant is native of the Himalayan region and its spread took place first in India and then in Egypt and from there throughout Europe. The fruit is cylindrical in shape, more or less elongated, green in colour, smooth or provided with small protrusions ending in a wrinkled dark papilla. The pulp is light green coloured and it contains white seeds. These fruits are eaten when they are still immature.
